## Fee Payment Schedule

The composite fee has to be paid four times a year along-with the applicable boarding and transport charges on or before the following dates:

1. 1<sup>st</sup> of March - composite term fee for the months of April, May and June.
2. 1<sup>st</sup> of July - composite term fee for the months of July, August and September.
3. 1<sup>st</sup> of October - composite term fee for the months of October, November and December.
4. 1<sup>st</sup> of January - composite term fee for the months of January, February and March.

## Notes

1. The composite fee includes the tuition fees, courseware, basic stationery, laboratory and library fees, on-campus meals and refreshments.
2. The composite fee does not include external examination charges levied by boards or external assessment bodies, uniform and any tours and excursions.
3. We do not levy any annual or recurring charges for English Language Support - ELS, Additional Learning Support - ALS and Special Education Needs - SEN.
4. The IB Diploma programme commences from July of every year. To get acquainted with the IBDP programme, students coming from different curriculums may enrol into the IBDP bridge course in the month of April. The bridge course will be charged USD 1500 for the quarter Apr- May-Jun.
5. Imprest deposit of USD 500 is to be maintained to meet the day to day or contingency expenses. These will be billed on actuals and can be accessed on the student management portal on a run-time basis.
6. Parents can avail 5% rebate on the total composite fees if they choose to pay the entire fees in one single instalment on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of April.
7. Sibling benefits will be extended on the younger child as follows:
  - a. 50% rebate on the admission fee
  - b. 50% rebate on the security deposit
  - c. 10% rebate on the composite fee until the siblings study together.
8. Weekly boarders wishing to stay over the weekend will be charged an additional amount of USD 50 per weekend.
9. Any student wishing to migrate from day boarding to boarding or vice versa, is required to inform the school before the commencement of the quarter.
10. In-case of transfers/withdrawals, parents must inform the school via email at least one month prior to the commencement of the new quarter failing which an amount equivalent to one quarter fee will be charged.
11. The security deposit and the remaining term fees for students expelled on the grounds of substance abuse, racial discrimination, fundamentalist activities, bullying, violence and or sexual misconduct will not be refunded.
12. The school management reserves the right to levy fines for late fee payments, and change or modify the current fee structure, payment schedule and/or the terms contained herein during the academic year without any prior notice.
13. Fee once paid shall not be refunded or adjusted.
